Transition from Classes to Co-op

School

Non fixed time to work

- Expected to go above and beyond
 - Your free time is limited and consumed by

classes, extracurriculars at school, etc

Co-op

- 40 Hr work week
- Should NOT be doing overtime as an intern
- Your free time is your own
 - No need to study outside of work hours

Work-Life Balance

- Reduces burnout
- Improves mental health
- Easier if you have a job you enjoy
- Set boundaries with work and yourself
 - I won't work for free on weekends, etc.

Succeeding as an Intern

Never put yourself in a position where you

have nothing to do during work hours

- Ask your leads for more tasking
- If you aren't working, you aren't learning

- Ask questions if you're confused!
 - You're an intern, you won't know everything
 - The worst thing from a lead standpoint is an

intern sitting on a task for three weeks

because they didn't know where to start

- Network!!!
 - The other interns are there for a reason,

learn from them!

- Connect with leads and management
 - References and return offers

- Be confident in yourself
 - You will be surprised how much impact you
 - can provide to projects as an intern
