

Now what?

Research Phase

Reach out to previous people that worked at that

company / current employees

- Alumni, RITSEC members, WiCyS, etc.
- Document the job description
 - Helps in preparing for the interview

Phone Screening

- First part of the interview phase
 - It serves as a baseline for the recruiter
 - Simple questions, 15-30 min
 - Basic qualifications
 - Will explain what the job is

Behavioral Interview

Purpose is to identify how you respond to certain

common workplace scenarios

- When is a time you experienced conflict during a group project, and what did you do?
- Come prepared with good examples

Technical Interview

- Heavily dependent on the actual job
 - Some won't have a technical
 - Best way to prep is ask other people that went

through the process for that company

Technical Interview

- HackerRank / LeetCode for SWEN roles
- For security it's generally scenario based
 - Given circumstance _x_ what would you do to

protect the system or attack it

Mock Interview

- Simulates an actual interview
 - One person takes the role of the interviewer
 - Other becomes the interviewee
- Extremely helpful in showing you what you need to

improve and preparing general responses
