What is the Glass Ceiling?

 Social barrier that prevents woman from being promoted to top jobs in management

Understanding the Glass Ceiling

- Marilyn Loden coined the phrase "glass ceiling" in 1978 at a Women's
 Exposition
- In 2021 women made 56.8% of the labor force in the U.S. but only held 29.1% of executive positions
 - In 2021 female chief execs leading fortune 500 companies was only 8.1%
- In 1991 the U.S. department of labor launched the Glass Centry Commision

Breaking the Glass Ceiling

- 1. Recognize that it exists
- 2. Understand that it is not a reflection of yourself
- 3. Trainings
- 4. Diversity Hiring and promotional goals
- 5. Company wide transparency
- 6. Talk to management
- 7. Mentor other women in the workplace
- 8. Offer resources

Glass Cliff

- When women get the leadership position during a time of crisis when failure is more likely
- Women who have broken through the glass ceiling will be places in very specific positions
- Term coined by Michell and Alexander from the university of Exeter, United Kingdom, in 2004
 - Conducted a study of Great Britain's FTSE 100 companies
